Automated Email Notifications

We have started our automated email Notifications. Our system will automatically send you notices when the following events occur: **1.** A hold is placed on an item for you. **2.** A hold is now available for you to pick up (In Stock Hold.) An in stock hold for a book is 3 days, In stock hold for a movie is 1 day. **3.** In stock hold has expired. **4.** Item becomes overdue (this is a daily reminder until item is returned.) **5.** Patron's account has overdue charges (this is a daily reminder until fines are paid.) "Overdue Charges" means the items have been returned but the fines have not been paid.

The following is an example of the email for overdue items or overdue charges. As you will noticed it has a "Date Due" and "Return Date" and "Fines." If there is a date under "Return Date" that means you have returned the item but the fines have not been paid. If it says "Not Returned" under the "Return Date" that means you have not returned the item.

The following items are overdue. Please return them to the library as quickly as possible so that others may use these resources.
